I understand that:

- I must attend school the day of the dance and the earliest that I can be picked up is 1 pm. If I am picked up early, I can only be checked out by someone who is on my approved pick up list in esis.
- Attire for boys is as follows: button down shirts and slacks with sports jackets or a suit and dress shoes. No hats or tuxedos.
- Attire for girls is as follows: semi-formal dresses (from Sunday-best to gowns). Strapless dresses are allowed with a wrap, jacket or shawl and must be worn at all times. Dresses cannot be low cut in the front. Length must adhere to Tucker guidelines.
- Students with unapproved attire will be asked to wait in the main office for parent pick-up.
- No electronic devices/cameras are allowed in the dance. We will have a photographer available if students want to have their pictures taken. Parents can take pictures in the lobby prior to student entering dance area. Parents are only allowed to take pictures of their child.
- **There will be no refunds, especially for those found in violation of the rules.**
- This is a semi-formal not a prom. Limousines are not allowed.
- **Your child must be picked up by 8:15PM.** The designated pick-up location is the parking lot in front of the school. **Please** do not ask students to meet you anywhere other than the designated pick-up location.
- Parents will be asked to drop student off in the lobby. Parents will not be allowed in the cafeteria. Chaperones will be on hand.
- School and district rules will be enforced during this event. Incidences of inappropriate behavior or dress will result in immediate phone call for pick-up and consequences according to the Student Code of Conduct.
- Any student who has received ISS or OSS May 11th will not be allowed at the dance. Also, no refunds will be given to those who have purchased tickets/paid their dues and have received OSS or ISS.
