Florida PTA 2010 Rally in Tally March 25, 2010

11:30 am to 1:30 pm



The Broward County Council of PTAs is offering TWO (2) planned choices for the trip to Tallahassee for your review. Please examine BOTH choices and let us know which trip suits YOUR needs the best. The Broward County Council is trying to get as many people as possible to Tallahassee for the Rally. With this in mind, we are setting up a day trip and an overnight trip.

Option # 1: The Bus departs from Lockhart Stadium at 12midnight 3/24/10, traveling 8 hours, with periodic stops through the night, arriving in Tallahassee at 8am-9am the morning of Thursday, March 25, 2010. Breakfast will be coordinated and people will be asked to meet on the steps of the Capital no later than 11:30am for the Florida PTA Rally. The Rally will take place from 11:30am-1:30pm. The group will then be gathered back onto the bus for the ride home. Leaving Tallahassee at 2pm and arriving back at Lockhart Stadium at 10:30pm-11pm with one stop for dinner. The cost of this trip would be: \$45.00 per person. Total passengers: 55, includes bus rides, water, snacks, t-shirt, breakfast in Tallahassee.

Option # 2: Trip Two: The bus departs from Lockhart Stadium at 5am Wednesday, March 24, 2010, traveling 8 hours with periodic stops through the day, arriving in Tallahassee at 1pm-2pm. People are directed to hotel check-ins and told to gather at 3:30pm-6:30pm for the Florida PTA Orientation. After Orientation the group has free time. The group reorganizes the next morning on the steps of the capital for the Florida PTA Rally. The Rally runs from 11:30am-1:30pm, the group is then gathered to the bus for the trip back to Lockhart Stadium. The suggested departure time: 2pm, arriving in Ft. Lauderdale around 10:30pm-11pm, with a dinner stop along the way. The cost of this trip would be: \$90.00 per person PLUS each person is responsible for their own hotel room and food for the TWO (2) days. Total passengers: 55, includes bus rides, water, snacks, t-shirt, breakfast in Tallahassee.
