

New CMS 1500 Implementation Reference Guide (Updated 3/19/14)

CMA surveyed the major payors in California to learn about each payor's requirement for submitting the new CMS 1500 (2/12 version) for dates of submission after April 1, 2014. Results are below. Aetna	No	 Aetna reports to CMA they will continue to allow practices to submit either CMS 1500 (version 08/05 or 02/12) after April 1, 2014. Aetna will require the new CMS 1500 form version (02/12) beginning October 1, 2014. More information can be found at www.aetna.com.
Anthem Blue Cross	Yes	• Anthem Blue Cross reports to CMA that they will require practices to submit the new CMS 1500 (version 02/12) on April 1, 2014. Any claims submitted on the old CMS 1500 form (08/05) will be rejected.
Blue Shield of California	No	• Blue Shield reports to CMA they will continue to allow practices to submit either CMS 1500 (version 08/05 or 02/12) on April 1, 2014. Blue Shield will notify providers at a later date as to when they will require use of the new CMS 1500 form (02/12). Cigna	No	• Cigna reports to CMA they will continue to allow practices to submit either CMS 1500 (version 08/05 or 02/12) on April 1, 2014. Cigna will notify providers at a later date as to when they will require use of the new CMS 1500 form version (02/12). Health Net	No	Health Net reports to CMA that they will continue to allow practices to submit either CMS 1500 (version 08/05 or 02/12) until the ICD-10 implementation date of October 1, 2014 .
Humana	Yes	Humana reports to CMA that they will require practices to submit the new CMS 1500 version on April 1, 2014. Any claims submitted on the old CMS 1500 form (08/05) will be rejected.
Medi-Cal	Yes	Beginning April 1, 2014, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will require practices to submit the new CMS 1500 form (version 02/12). Any claims submitted on the old CMS 1500 form (08/05) will be rejected.
Medicare	Yes	• CMS will require practices to submit the new CMS 1500 form (version 02/12) on April 1, 2014. Any claims submitted on the old CMS 1500 form (08/05) will be rejected. For more information, please see the CMS.gov website.
United Healthcare	Yes	United Healthcare reports to CMA that they will require practices to submit the new CMS 1500 claim form (version 02/12) effective April 1, 2014.
