TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- Age is in accordance with the Tennis New Zealand Seniors Inc. Constitution i.e. 35 years of age or older for both women and men (on or before 25th July 2015). All participants must be a financial member of a Seniors Tennis Association.
- Reporting time both days is 8.30am, play commences at 9.00am.
- Doubles are played on Saturday, Mixed Doubles is played on Sunday.
- Plate events will be held in each doubles and mixed doubles grades to ensure a minimum of 3 matches, where draw permits.
- The tournament will be held predominantly indoors and will not be cancelled if weather is inclement, however, some outdoor courts may be used should the need arise due to draw sizes and if weather permits.
- Each doubles and mixed doubles match will be played first to 9 (or 11) games, with a 12-point Tie-breaker at 8 (or 10) games all.
- Tournament Organisers reserve the right to amend match, draw and score formats and to balance draws, where conditions dictate.
- Prize giving will be held at the conclusion of each day's play.
