The tournament uses two award-winning Jack Nicklaus designed courses at Grand Cypress. There are contests for hole-in-one, longest drive, closest to the pin and putting along with a premier raffle/silent auction and giveaways. This tournament provides a great opportunity to meet and network with some of Central Florida's leading business people and school district VIPs while investing in the education of our future leaders.

### Adding Value to Our Schools

In addition to raising funds to support eight Orange County Public Schools district-wide initiatives, the Foundation for OCPS manages several programs.

**Read2Succeed** - Our Foundation created this successful program to assist struggling 1st and 2nd graders with increasing their vocabulary and reading fluency.



### Middle School Book Clubs

Currently 19 book clubs established in 12 OCPS middle schools, the clubs are designed to facilitate pleasure reading via e-readers and to develop and increase the joy of reading to our reluctant readers.

**Teacher Grants Program** - Classroom teachers across the District received more than \$190,000 in teacher grants in 2014 for innovative teaching and instruction for District students.

**Teach-In 2014** - Over 4,500 volunteers contributed more than 8,000 volunteer hours in 175 OCPS schools sharing stories, careers and giving demonstrations.



The Foundation continues to provide support by matching teacher and school needs with business community leadings that want to invest in making a sustainable difference.
