## Summer Enrichment Camp

Join us this summer at **Allendale** for a fun experience. ENCORE! offers opportunities for children, who have completed Kindergarten through 5th grades (by the end of the school year), to attend a week-long camp designed to provide exploratory learning experiences based upon individual interests. We hope to ignite and foster a love of learning through challenging, creative, and interactive educational classes. Before and after care is available for our working parents from SACC. We are looking forward to this opportunity to share some summer fun with you and your family.

- Each student will attend 5 classes daily.
- Classes last for 55 minutes and are designed for 7-10 students.
- Students will bring a sack lunch with a drink each day.
- Parents are welcome to attend a closing assembly on Friday, where students will share their experience. More information to follow.

## **1 in a Minion!**

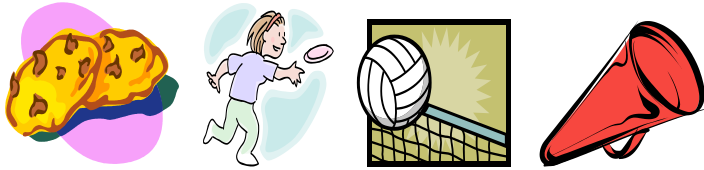
Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)

Offered July 13-17 only (appropriate for all ages)

## **Amazing Animals around the World**

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)

Did you know that a beaver's teeth never stop growing or that a snail can grow back a new eye? Learn about these amazing animals around the world as we read, watch videos, and enjoy some arts and crafts along the way.

## **American Girl Doll Accessories**

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)

## ***Creative Computing***

Offered June 8-12 only (appropriate for all ages)

Students will create their own interactive stories, games, and animations. "Scratch" is a program language and online community where students will design individual projects while thinking creatively. A great intro to programming!



## ***Creative Cupcakes***

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages) !!Allergy Alert!!  
This class is an introduction to the essentials of becoming a master cupcake decorator. We will read recipes, measure ingredients, and make beautiful treats. Learn a variety of creative cupcake decorating techniques.

## ***Cursive Camp***

Offered both weeks (for students that completed 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade)  
We will review the proper formation of manuscript letters and move quickly into cursive writing. Just to make it fun we will use a variety of pens, pencils, markers, and paper =)



## ***Dancing Through the Decades***

Offered July 13-17 only (appropriate for all ages)  
Each day we will focus on a different decade of dancing. Decades include: 50's, 70's, 80's, and 2000's. Students will learn how dancing has evolved through the decades. We will also be comparing styles of dance, music, dress, and the impact it had on that decade. It will be fun for all ages!

## ***Deep Oceans***

## ***I Can Sculpt***

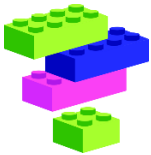
Offered July 13-17 only (for students that completed 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade)

## ***Scrapbooking/Card Making***

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)  
Students will be producing pages for their scrapbooks in class that will be reflective of them. They will need to bring a scrapbook, or they can use what is provided by the teacher. We will also be working on our writing skills, as we use our words to describe what we create.

## ***The Secret Life of Bees***

Offered the week of July 13-17 only (appropriate for all ages)  
What's all the buzz about? Bees! Did you know most of the food you eat today would not exist if not for bees? We will explore inside a bee colony, learn why bees are so important and how they make such yummy honey, and meet a real bee keeper and help harvest honey.

## ***Sharpie Art***

*Students will need a white t-shirt*

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)  
Let's get creative with Sharpies and learn some new ways to use them!

## ***So You Think You Can Dance and Sing?***

Offered the week of June 8-12 only (appropriate for all ages)  
The stage is calling your name to showcase your dance moves. You will learn new dance moves for two routines that you will perform on Friday while also having the opportunity to karaoke during our rest breaks.



## ***Soccer***

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)  
Students will learn the fundamentals of soccer. How to kick, dribble, and pass soccer balls as well as throw-ins and scoring.

## ***Solar System Spray Can Art***

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)  
The sky is the limit! Students will learn and use the neat techniques of doing spray can art. You will use different materials such as different textures of paper, shapes, and spray paint to make your own unique and one of a kind solar system. Every single one is amazing!

### ***To Be or Not to Be?***

Offered the week of June 8-12 only (appropriate for all ages)  
This is a class of role-playing from nonfiction and/or fiction stories. Costumes will be worn and the creative juices will be flowing. Students will use this opportunity to play and learn at the same time. Role-play stimulates students' imagination, enhances their social development, and encourages friendship through cooperation, listening, and turn taking.

### ***Upcycling with a Purpose*** *Students will need an old t-shirt*

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)  
Repurpose and rescue materials to be used in a new way! We will be making a reusable shopping bag, and greeting cards and note cards.



### ***Wacky Weaving***

Offered both weeks (appropriate for all ages)  
Students will be creating looms and weaving to create artwork. We will be using yarn, sticks, paper, ribbon, and anything else we find that can be utilized in our artwork. Students will be creating a wall hanging, a funny character, and a dream catcher in addition to wrist bands, lanyards/necklaces, and headbands.
