- ➤ College Acceptance Letter (copy)
- Official High School Transcript
- ➤ SAT or ACT Scores (copy)
- Two Reference Letters: These letters may be from current or previous teachers who are familiar with the applicant's dedication and determination as a student and/or from one teacher and one adult with ongoing and current knowledge of the applicant's qualifications. Reference letters may be mailed directly to the Scholarship Chairperson c/o Service League of Cherokee County, P.O. Box 1132, Canton, GA 30169. Reference letters must be received before your application will be considered.

## <u>Completed applications and materials must be submitted to the Service League of</u> Cherokee County by the close of business on March 29, 2013.

A committee of representatives from the Service League of Cherokee County will review all applications. Representatives from the Service League of Cherokee County will recognize the students chosen to receive the scholarships at each high school's awards ceremony in the Spring.

<sup>\*</sup> Scholarship award monies will be paid directly to the postsecondary institution on a semester basis in the amount of \$500.00 for each of two semesters (\$1,000 total) as long as the student is enrolled full time and is in good academic and behavioral standing. Award recipients will be required to forward a copy of their academic transcript to the Scholarship Chairperson at the end of the first semester and will forfeit the remainder of the scholarship if their GPA falls below 2.0, if they do not remain in good standing behaviorally or if they are not enrolled for more than one semester or quarter.

<b>Form is complete and accurate.</b> Please use your full legal name, complete address (including P. O. Box, apartment number, etc.) to avoid confusion when matching references with scholarship application.

All inquiries within the application are answered completely, honestly and within the parameters given. Some questions require multiple responses within tight restraints in an effort to force applicants to be concise yet forthright.
Reference letters have been completed and submitted to the appropriate persons for completion. Contact your references early and provide them with ample time to complete and submit the letters. <u>Please be aware, the committee will not act as the intermediary between you and your references.</u> Please follow-up with each reference regularly until such time as all letters have been submitted.
<b>All information is legible.</b> Please consider requesting an electronic (Word or Adobe form document) version of the application from <a href="mailto:serviceleaguescholarship@gmail.com">serviceleaguescholarship@gmail.com</a> so you may type directly onto the form and print the final version.
Student and Parent/Legal Guardian Signatures are included. Please ensure that both you and your parent/legal guardian have signed and dates the last page of the application.
Application is submitted to the Service League of Cherokee County on or before March 29, 2013. Applications that are incomplete, illegible, late or that otherwise do not follow directions may not be considered for funding.

## Service League of Cherokee County Scholarship Application Timeline

The following is a brief timeline of the scholarship application and decision-making process, for your information only. Please be aware that unforeseen events may alter this timeline but every effort will be made to assure timely communication.

February 1, 2013	Flyers, application and reference forms sent to Cherokee County School District High Schools for distribution to counselors, teachers and students.	
February 1 – March 29	Students complete scholarship application and reference forms.	
February – March	Applications matched with appropriate reference forms. If an application is missing one or more reference forms, the student is called and provided an opportunity to contact the reference(s).	
March 29, 2013	Application deadline	
April 15, 2013	Committee recommends applicants as recipients of the scholarship awards.	
April 15, 2013	Students are notified of committee decisions.	
April – May	Scholarship recipients are recognized at appropriate high school's annual awards ceremony.	
August 2013	Award checks will be mailed from the Service League of Cherokee County directly to the applicable postsecondary institution to be credited to the scholarship recipient's account.
