Bill suffered a traumatic spinal cord injury in 1984. From that point forward he used a manual wheelchair to get around. In 1986 Bill helped form Campus Colleague; campus club for both able bodied and disabled students. In 1990 he was selected as the Disabled Student of the Year at OCC. In 1991 Bill was the heart and soul in the development of the Disabled Students' High Tech Center. In 1996 he initiated and organized the first in a series of Wheelchair Rugby charity exhibition games on campus to benefit the OCC Campus Colleagues/Spirit of Ability scholarship fund.

This memorial scholarship is awarded to a disabled student who has demonstrated academic performance, has been involved in campus activities and has strong educational goals. Additionally, an interest in some athletic activities in and around the campus is a plus for this student.
