

2011 Pertussis (Whooping Cough) Immunization Requirements for Students Assembly Bill 354

Whooping cough (pertussis) has been widespread in California during 2010. The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) recommends that all Californians 10 years or older receive a booster shot against pertussis (also known as “Tdap”). Moreover, Assembly Bill 354, is now chaptered into California

All student information must be updated prior to registration for the 2011-2012 school year.

Please bring a copy of your child’s immunization card or this completed form to the HBHS Health Office by June 3, 2011. Please note that our school offices will be closed the month of July. In the event that your child has already received this immunization, please bring a copy of your immunization record to the HBHS Health Office so that we may update your student’s records.

For the 2011-12 School Year

All students entering 7th—12th grades will need proof of a Tdap booster shot before starting school. This requirement:

- Begins July 1, 2011
- Can be met by the CDPH recommendation to receive one dose of Tdap vaccine on or after the 10th birthday.
- Applies to all public and private schools.
