Please help your camper pack her things in a duffle, backpack or suitcase. Plastic bags tear easily and are not suggested. Involve your camper in packing so she can easily find her items once at camp. Please label her items with waterproof marker.

In a separate bag for Check-In:

Do not bring the following to camp:

-  MP3s, iPod's, hand-held video games, televisions or electric appliances.
-  Food/candy
-  Any spaghetti strap tops, or any shorts that are shorter than the camper's fingertips. This is to prevent sunburn & excessive bug bites. Open-toed shoes or sandals are only permitted to be worn at the pool house.
-  **NO CAMPERS ARE PERMITTED TO HAVE CELL PHONES AT CAMP.**

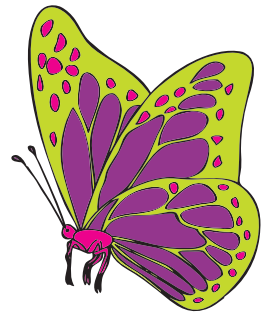
