Do not bring the following to camp:

- MP3s, IPod's, hand-held video games, televisions or electric appliances.
- Food/candy
- Any spaghetti strap tops, or any shorts that are shorter than the camper's fingertips. This is to prevent sunburn & excessive bug bites. Open-toed shoes or sandals are only permitted to be worn at the pool house.
