

# **Donation Receipt**

Donated items must be in good used condition or better. The IRS requires that you, the donor, estimate the fair market value of donated items. For reference in determining value and additional information visit www.irs.gov or contact your tax advisor.

- Donations valued at less than \$250 Complete this receipt and retain for your records.
- If a single donated item is valued at more than \$250 OR if all donated items together are valued at more than \$500 The IRS requires a donor to obtain a written acknowledgement from Bridging. To obtain this acknowledgement, please email your request to receipt@bridging.org. The request must include your name, mailing address for where the letter should be sent, the date of your donation, and a description of the items you donated. Bridging will provide a statement that acknowledges the donated item(s), not the value.
