Explore a Digital Classroom with Kerri Sands and Martin Evans




Join us for a hands-on lesson to experience the digital classroom in a simulation of what students experience in Flagler Schools. Valuable for all grade levels.


Join us to learn more about the flagships programs, career and technical classes, and opportunities at FTI that support students on their journey from classroom to career. Valuable for all grade levels.
