Format and Rules

Date/Time: Saturday, April 19th 2014. 7 a.m.-2:30p.m. fishing hours
6:30-6:50 a.m.: All live wells checked
Release at 7 a.m.—all Teams depart from Bucksaw Marina
Mush be in weigh-in line by 3:30 p.m.
Location: Truman Reservoir
Entry Fee: \$100 per team for Bass or Crappie. \$200 for both
Paybacks: 60% 1 of 5 boats wins!
Big fish pot—\$10 entry (70% to first place, 30% to second place)
Divisions: Open
Seminar: Friday, April 18th, 6:00-7:00pm—Bucksaw Marina pavilion
Rules meeting starts at 7:00pm
Registrations will be taken at seminar. Vouchers given there.

Late registration: 5:45 –6:30 a.m. Sat. April 19th at Bucksaw Marina

RULES:

- Tournament will abide by Missouri state fishing and boating rules and regulations
- Teams must consist of 2 people in a participating boat during tournament hours
- Seminar—One team member must be present.
- Weather—In the case of extreme/dangerous weather/water conditions, the tournament will be rescheduled.
- Fishing hours are 7 a.m.-2:30 p.m. All boats must be in the weigh-in line by 3:30p.m.
- Entry to tournament can be done by mail, or at the seminar. All entrants must sign the Waiver of Liability before participating. If under age 18, a parent/guardian must sign waiver and also the release to allow a polygraph exam.
- Sportsmanship—Competitors are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation. Any infraction of these fundamental sporting principals may be deemed cause of disqualification.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed during the seminar or during the tournament.
- Baits—1 bait per pole may be used for bass, 2 for Crappie. Live and artificial baits are allowed for Crappie, only artificial for Bass.
- Binoculars and other magnifying devices are not allowed at any time. Under water cameras are not allowed. Cellular phones, radios, walkie talkies, and any other communications devices are not allowed during the tournament.
- Spotting—no one may spot fish or mark fishing spots for you during the tournament.
- Landing Fish—Fish must be hooked through the lip or in the mouth. Landing nets are permitted.
- Life Jackets—personal flotation devices/life jackets must be worn when large motor is running.

WEIGH-IN

- Voucher—a weigh-in voucher will be issued to each registered team at the seminar. This voucher must be presented back to the tournament director at the weigh-in.
- Early Weigh-In: Early weigh-in is allowed starting at 12:30pm, but ALL Fish must be weighed in at that time and there will be no additional weigh-in for that team.
- Fish—Bass: A team cannot weigh-in more than 5 bass measuring a minimum of 15". All fish must be alive. Any teams presenting more fish than the limits above will be disqualified. Once you enter the weigh-in, your fish will be counted and verified dead or alive. Once your fish have been verified alive and entered on the weigh-in voucher, you will then be allowed to weigh-in those fish, even if one or more die before reaching the scales. The Tournament Director has sole responsibility for the declaration of dead or alive fish. No mutilated fish will be weighed.
- Fish—Crappie: A team cannot weigh-in more than 7 crappie measuring a minimum of 9". All fish must be alive. Any teams presenting more fish than the limits above will be disqualified. Once you enter the weigh-in, your fish will be counted and verified dead or alive. Once your fish have been verified alive and entered on the weigh-in voucher, you will then be allowed to weigh-in those fish, even if one or more die before reaching the scales. The Tournament Director has sole responsibility for the declaration of dead or alive fish. No mutilated fish will be weighed.
- Ties: In the case of a tie for 1st Place, big fish of each boat will determine the winner.
- Polygraph: Polygraph tests will be given to first place in the bass division, crappie division and the big fish winner if requested by the Tournament Director.
