

Student Information and Behavior Contract

This contract must be signed by the student and a parent/guardian listed on the student's emergency card and submitted prior to purchasing a ticket. Students and guests are required to abide by all school rules and the terms of this contract.

Purchasing a Ticket:

1. Tickets will only be sold to WHS seniors possessing a current student ID card and their approved guests with a bid. Students with fines will not be allowed to purchase a senior ball ticket. Tickets will only be sold to students and guests who have signed contracts on file.
2. Ticket prices will vary throughout the ticket-sales period, and exceptions will not be granted to students who do not have bids cleared in time to receive discounted prices. For more information on ticket sales times and pricing, please check the school website under "Activities & Programs" and then "Student Government". Choose the folder on the left for "Senior Ball Information".
3. Bids are available starting April 21 through the attendance office or on the school website under "Activities & Programs" and then "Student Government". Choose the folder on the left for "Senior Ball Information" to download the bid form. All bids are due to the office by 3:45 pm on Thursday, April 30th. **NO NON-WOODCREEK STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE DANCE WITHOUT A BID, AN ID CARD AND A TICKET!** NO BID WILL BE APPROVED FOR ANYONE 21 OR OLDER! Admittance:

1. Admittance/attendance is subject to WHS Administration approval.
2. All students must present an ID card at the door for admission. Woodcreek students must present a valid Student ID Card. Guests of Woodcreek students must present a picture ID. **Students or guests without the appropriate ID will NOT be admitted!**
3. All school rules related to substance and alcohol use are in effect.
4. Doors open at 8 pm and will close at 9 pm. No re-admittance will be allowed. Students will not be allowed in the parking lot area or any area outside of the designated secure area until they leave the event. Students are not required to attend the entire dance. Senior Ball is over at 11 pm, and all students must be off Sacramento Grand Ballroom premises by 11:15 pm.
5. Only envelope-sized purses allowed into the venue. These must be checked at coat check and are subject to search. Cars of students attending Senior Ball may be searched for alcohol, drugs or weapons. **Students are not allowed to change clothing at Sacramento Grand Ballroom.**
6. All students needing to park a car at Sacramento Grand Ballroom must use valet parking. Sacramento Grand Ballroom offers no self-parking. Valet tickets can be purchased along with your Senior Ball ticket for \$15.

Rules:

1. Please refer to the school handbook. All school rules will be enforced! Rule infractions may result in school discipline.
2. Students under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted and will be subject to school and criminal penalty.
 - a. If students are found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any time during Senior Ball, parents will be contacted and will be expected to come and pick their student up at Sacramento Grand Ballroom no later than 11:00 pm.
 - b. Students found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be suspended from school, and may be cited by the police.
 - c. Any student found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be placed on "Senior Conduct", and may be excluded from senior events including the graduation ceremony.
3. Students who purchase tickets are required to inform their guests of all contract rules. Guests are required to abide by all school rules and the terms of this contract. Any student or guest exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance and the student or guest will be released to the WHS student parent or police if parent(s) cannot be reached. The Woodcreek High School student will be held accountable for the behavior of their guest. No reimbursement or refund will be given when asked to leave the dance for not following this agreement.
4. Dancing must be appropriate, and dress code will be enforced! Please refer to the "Dance Policy" and the "Dance Dress Code Policy" for more information. All students attending Senior Ball are expected to abide by the rules detailed in the "Dance Policy" and the "Dance Dress Code Policy" documents.
