- Tabling is FREE of charge, but you must RSVP for a table by September 30, 2015. Tables will be assigned by order of reservation until we have no additional room.
- Tables are 6' long, typically 2 chairs per table. You may opt to sign up for half a table if you only require that much space.
- Tables must be set up between 7:30AM-8:30PM and must be dismantled by 7:00PM at the LATEST.
- We are not responsible for missing materials or theft of materials. Leave your table unsupervised at your own risk.
- NO SHIPPING of materials prior to the conference. We will not be able to offer storage space for tabling materials at any time before or after the conference. You will be responsible for transport and set-up of all of your own materials prior to, during, and after the event.
- Table may be used for recruitment, distribution of information, and canvassing. Groups may not use table for commercial solicitation (selling of items) or for programming purposes.\*
- No audio displays without prior approval.
- You may bring pop-up banners and table banner, but no wall hangings/signs attached to the wall are allowed.

\*The only exception is for panelists who may choose to make their books available for sale. We are not responsible for sales of books. If you are a panelist who would like to take advantage of selling your books, please bring someone to handle your merchandising.
