

DRIVER EDUCATION BEHIND-THE-WHEEL (BTW) INFORMATION SHEET

- The cost for Driver Education Behind-the-Wheel training is \$252.
- Rates are subject to change.
- You should have your driver's instruction permit to apply for BTW. You may take your instruction permit test at any Minnesota driver's license exam station. The closest stations are in Faribault and Eagan. No appointments are needed for the test.
- Sign up for BTW as soon as possible after you have passed your instruction permit test as there may be a **one to two and a half** month waiting list.
- You will be called approximately one week before you are scheduled for BTW. Unless otherwise notified, meet the driving instructor at the Northfield High School, main entrance.
- If a primary driving supervisor (parent/guardian) has completed the Supplemental Parental Curriculum, the requirements for a provisional license include submitting a driving log that states the applicant has driven a motor vehicle accompanied by and under the supervision of a licensed driver at least 21 years of age, for no less than 40 total hours, at least 15 of which were nighttime hours, identifies dates and lengths of driving time for each supervised driving trip, and is signed by the primary driving supervisor. The Supplemental Parental Curriculum Course Certificate of Completion should also be submitted. *A Supervised Driving Log from the State of Minnesota Department of Public Safety is copied on the back of this page.
- If a primary driving supervisor (parent/guardian) has not completed the Supplemental Parental Curriculum, a supervised driving log for no less than 50 total hours, at least 15 of which were nighttime hours, needs to be submitted. *A Supervised Driving Log from the State of Minnesota Department of Public Safety is copied on the back of this page.
- If you are under 19 years of age, you need to wait 6 months after you receive a permit and have taken BTW training before you may take your driver's road test.
- If you are 19 or older, you need to wait 3 months after you receive a permit before you may take your driver's road test.
- After completing six hours of BTW, you will receive a Certificate of Completion, referred to as a white card. You will need this card to take your driver's road test. Cost for replacement of lost or damaged cards is \$10.
- You may take your driver's road test at any Minnesota Driver's license exam station. The closest stations are in Faribault and Eagan. Appointments are needed for the test. Call for appointments or sign up online at www.mndriveinfo.org.

Faribault: Select Building, 1105 West Division Street, Faribault. Call 507.334.7200 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday for appointments for a road test. Times are subject to change.

Eagan: 2070 Cliff Road, Eagan. Call 651.688.1870 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday for appointments for a road test. Times are subject to change.
