- Submissions must be a maximum of 500 words.
- There is no entry fee or cost to the writer.
- Students currently affiliated with Enbridge Energy in any capacity, including relatives of employees, are not eligible to participate.
- The winner will need to submit the contact information for the university, technical school or trade school they will be attending. The scholarship will be submitted by check directly to each winner's school.
