

LET'S WELCOME OUR STUDY PROGRAM STUDENTS from SPAIN! On

Saturday night, 14 students from Madrid, Spain will arrive at the Tampa International Airport to be greeted by our Spanish Department teachers and 14 Corbett Prep families to kick off our 2012-2013 International Study Program opportunity. Over 30 students, in grades 5 through 8 from Madrid's highly acclaimed *Colegio Ramon Y Cajal* applied to participate in this opportunity. It's hard to believe, but this is already the sixth year that we have welcomed our international guests, and the success of our students connecting with students from different backgrounds and languages has been overwhelmingly wonderful. Our students will again have the same opportunity in March 2013 to spend time in their school. We ask everyone to help welcome our visiting students and their teachers who will be with us for three weeks.

THIRD, FOURTH, AND FIFTH GRADE STUDENTS TRAVEL TO

UNIVERSITY OF TAMPA: Over 150 Corbett Prep teachers and third, fourth, and fifth grade students traveled to the University of Tampa on Friday, September 28 for a two hour hands-on science field trip. The University of Tampa has formed a relationship with Corbett Prep to provide these field trips hosted by the College of Education students who are preparing for their internships next semester. The UT students gained valuable experience working with our students in science, while our Corbett Prep students participated in activities related to the topics they are currently studying in their classrooms. The UT students were well prepared with many creative lessons and provided interactive group activities that ranged from using clay to learning about the bones of the human body to demonstrating physical and chemical change by cooking pancakes. Cindy Strickland, Corbett Prep Assistant Middle School Director and UT instructor, proudly reported that the UT students and Professors were impressed with Corbett Prep students' knowledge in the field of science as well as their exemplary behavior.







CARROLLWOOD DAY SCHOOL: 1515 W. Bearss Avenue: 920-2288 (for Cross Country meets; try to get here after 3:30 if possible because otherwise, you will get in the dismissal crowd.) We have 2 entrances off Bearss Ave. and either one is ok to enter and park (buses may have more room and be easier to park if you enter on the East side, which would be the one closest to Florida Ave.). You will see parking spaces as you come in...park where you can. Meeting area will be north of the school.

COUNTRY PLACE PARK – WEST: From IDS, north on Dale Mabry Hwy to Ehrlich. Left on Ehrlich to Hutchison. Right on Hutchison and park will be about a mile down on the right, before you get to the Veterans. (If you are picking up at the park, you MUST be there by 4:40pm because we will need to load up the bus to get back to IDS in time for a 5:00pm pick-up).

BERKELEY PREP SCHOOL: 4811 Kelly Rd. Tampa, 885-1673. Dale Mabry south to the Hillsborough exit. Take a right onto Hillsborough at the end of the ramp. Left onto Kelly Road (TJ Maxx and Mobil station on the corner). The school is on the left.
