| The $8\pi$ $\gamma$ -ray spectrometer, located at the TRIUMF radioactive beam facility in Vancouver, is the world's most powerful device used for $\beta$ -decay studies. We have a very active programme of investigations for weak interaction studies, through high-precision superallowed Fermi $\beta$ decay, as well as nuclear structure. The nuclear structure studies utilize in addition to the 20 germanium detectors for $\gamma$ -ray detection, 5 Si(Li) detectors for conversion electrons, and 10 BaF $_2$ or LaBr $_3$ detectors for fast lifetime measurements. Experiments performed with the $8\pi$ spectrometer thus involve a very complex data set. The research to be performed by the student involves the analysis of data from $8\pi$ experiments. The student will use existing, sophisticated analysis codes to perform the data analysis. This will involve analyzing coincidence relationships to build the excited-state level scheme, fitting spectra to determine key branching ratios, etc. The student will be based at the University of Guelph. Travel to TRIUMF in Vancouver and other locations may be necessary to support the group research. |   |              |  |  |
