

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRY, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF THE PERRY MUNICIPAL CODE 2004 (3RD ANNUAL SUPPLEMENT), BY THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 4-134, PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN EUTHANIZING FEE, BOARDING FEE, TRANQUILIZER FEE, ANIMAL OWNER RELINQUISHMENT FEE, SETTING AND MONITORING LIVE TRAPS; BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 4-138, PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION PROCESSING FEES; REPEALER; SAVINGS CLAUSE; CODIFICATION; SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Section I. That Chapter 4 of the Perry Municipal Code 2004 (3rd Bi-annual Supplement) is hereby amended by the amendment of Section 4-134 and a new Section 4-138 which shall read as follows:

	<u>Set City Trap and Check Daily (per day)</u>	<u>\$5.00</u>
	<u>Personally owned traps (pick up fee)</u>	<u>\$10.00</u>
4-138	<u>Adoption Processing Fee</u> and <u>boarding fees</u>	<u>\$25.00 and impound</u>

Section II. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. SAVINGS CLAUSE. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

Section IV. CODIFICATION. This ordinance shall be codified as herein provided.

Section V. SEVERABILITY. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall for any reason be held invalid, the invalidity of

such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Perry, Oklahoma, that this section of the Perry Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section VI. EMERGENCY. WHEREAS, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and public good of the City and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this Ordinance be put into full force and effect in order to immediately provide for these fees relating to animals; By reason whereof, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage, as provided by law.
