Animal Ethics Committee Confidentiality Agreement

CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of participating as a member of the CHM Alliance Pty Ltd Animal Ethics Committee, the undersigned hereby agrees and acknowledges:

- 1. That during the course of my involvement I may have access to commercial-inconfidence information consisting of:
 - Technical information: methods, processes, formulae, compositions, inventions, machines, computer programs and research projects
 - Business information: Customer lists; pricing data; sources of supply; and marketing, production, or merchandising systems or plans.
- 2. I shall not during, or at any time after the termination of my membership of the CHM Alliance Pty Ltd Animal Ethics Committee, use for myself or others, or disclose or divulge to others any trade secrets, confidential information, or any other data of CHM Alliance Pty Ltd or companies involved in research projects in violation of this agreement.
- 3. That upon the termination of my membership of the CHM Alliance Pty Ltd Animal Ethics Committee:
 - I shall return to CHM Alliance Pty Ltd all documents relating to the activities of the committee, including but not necessarily limited to: drawings, blueprints, reports, manuals, correspondence, customer lists, computer programs and all other materials and all copies thereof relating in any way to CHM Alliance Pty Ltd activities, or in any way obtained by me during the course of my involvement. I further agree that I shall not retain any copies of the foregoing.
 - This agreement shall be binding upon me and my personal representatives and successors in interest, and shall inure to the benefit of CHM Alliance Pty Ltd, its successors and assigns.
 - The unenforceability of any provision to this agreement shall not impair or affect any other provision.
 - In the event of any breach of this agreement, CHM Alliance Pty Ltd shall have full rights to injunctive relief, in addition to any other existing rights, without requirement of posting bond.
