By submitting this application, the applicant certifies that they understand that scholarships provided by SDRA may be paid in two installments, and that scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time in a retail or business related course of study to receive any and all monies.

ELIGIBILITY

This application is for students who plan to attend post secondary school during the 2012-2013 school year.

- 1. To be eligible, applicant must enroll in a retail or business related course of study at a vocational technical school, college or university, or other trade school in the fall of 2012. Students planning to attend post secondary schools outside of South Dakota are eligible if they graduated from a South Dakota high school.
 - Examples of areas of study considered to be retail or business related may include (but are not be limited to): Accounting, Agribusiness, Animal Science/Veterinary Technician, Apparel Merchandising, Auto Mechanics, Automotive Technology, Banking, Business Administration, Business Management, Collision Repair, Computer Science, Commercial Baking, Culinary Arts, Diesel Mechanics, Electrical Maintenance, Heating/Ventilation, Hotel/Restaurant Management, Landscape Design, Pharmacy, Photography, Printing Industries, Refrigeration, Sales/Marketing Management, and Tourism Industry Management. (Note: this list is not all-inclusive).
- 2. Applicant <u>must</u> desire a career in a retail or business field.
- 3. Applicant <u>must</u> have completed at least one year of college or one semester of vocational school by September of 2012 to be eligible. (Students who are in high school and have not attended college or vocational school are not eligible).
- 4. Student <u>must</u> enroll full-time at a post secondary school for the fall of 2012. Internships are not eligible for scholarship funds.
- 5. Awards will not be based solely on financial need or grades.
- 6. Application must be postmarked or emailed by April 10, 2012 to be eligible for consideration.
- 7. Additional materials: most recent **grade transcript and letters of reference must be postmarked or emailed by April 10, 2012**.
- 8. Names of scholarship recipients will be announced in July of 2012.
- 9. Previous recipients <u>are eligible</u> to apply for the scholarship program.
- 10. Children and spouses of current members of the SDRA Scholarship Committee are not eligible for consideration.
- 11. Applicants will be notified by postcard when SDRA receives the application.
- 12. All scholarships awarded will be paid directly to the school to be applied to tuition.
