The time slots for *fall conferences have changed from the <u>morning</u> of <i>Friday, October 11 to the* <u>afternoon</u> of October 11. If your conference form indicated other available times than the morning of October 11, we will schedule you for those times. Otherwise, if you only had Friday available, we will now schedule you for an afternoon time slot.

As always, we will send home conference confirmation letters and you will have an opportunity to request a different time and day, if needed. If the afternoon of Friday, October 11, between 12 PM and 3:45 PM, is now your first choice, please contact the office before Monday to have your preference noted.

This October is our first "official" goal setting conference. The purpose of this conference is to set goals in mathematics, reading and work habits for the year, and will not be a conference to share specific academic content.

Hi, my name is Sarah Terpstra, and I am the student advocate for Withrow and Marine Elementary. I received my bachelors in Social Work at St. Cloud State University and my Masters in Social Work at Augsburg college. After graduating from St. Cloud State I was a Head Start Family Advocate, but within a month became a Child Protection Social Worker for Kandiyohi County in Willmar, MN. Needing a change I became a School Social Worker at Howard Lake-Waverly-Winsted, but after a year decided to stay home with my daughter. After four years of being a stay at home parent I was contacted by the principal at Cokato Elementary to sub for the other School Social Worker which I did and was later hired on a part time basis for the past six years. This past year I was also being trained as a play therapist. I also co-facilitated a Kinship group for family members that are raising children that are not necessarily their own.

This past spring my husband, Chad, and I decided that we needed to make a change because he was driving from Dassel, MN to Hugo, MN every day, so that is how I came to Withrow and Marine. My family and I are currently in the process of adjusting to our new community in Osceola, WI. We have a daughter, Chloe (age 10) and a son, Blake (age 7). My family and I like to travel, camp, hike, and play games.
