Hold Hands—
It feels good and it helps
the square

Some of the good things
that keeping contact
can do for the dancers
are:

- Help dancers find their proper position in the set's formation
- Help dancers keep track of what the set as a whole is doing (formation awareness, and it is very important that new dancers learn it early in their class)
- Help keep them together time-wise
- Make it easier for the more experienced dancers to assist or cue the others (guiding but not pushing or yanking, of course)
- Encourage the dancers to keep the set neat and compact.

So remember—always
take the hands next to
you in the formation,
but use a gentle grip to
keep them comfortably
close.

These associations are part of larger state associations. Dancers are encouraged to get involved at every level of club, area, and state leadership. It is these leaders who take the responsibility to do everything from recruiting new dancers, scheduling dances and hiring callers all the way up to arranging state and national dance conventions.
