Bridges to College Application Criteria for Last Dollar Grants 2012-13 School Year

Bridges to College will offer last-dollar renewable grants of up to \$1,000 to selected graduates of Greenville High School and Ansonia High School who have demonstrated unmet need. Grant award winners will be selected by a review committee.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be considered for a last-dollar grant, all applicants must meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Graduating high school seniors attending high schools served by Bridges to College (this is Greenville High School and Ansonia High School only in 2012) are eligible to apply. Students are eligible to apply up to 5 years after graduation from high school.
- 2. Students shall be considered for a grant only after they have demonstrated that they have applied for all other sources of financial aid, and they demonstrate financial need as determined by federal guidelines.
- 3. Students must meet the minimum Grade Point Average requirement of 2.0 annually.
- 4. To be eligible for grants, student must attend an accredited post-secondary institution. Students enrolling full-time (12 credit hours or more) will receive the maximum benefit of the scholarship award. Students enrolling part-time (6 to 11 credit hours) will receive a prorated or adjusted scholarship award based on enrollment. Grants will be awarded for undergraduate education only.
- 5. All grants will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution at the beginning of each term.
- 6. Students shall submit to the Bridges to College office their registration for the upcoming quarter/semester before grants for subsequent terms will be issued to the college or university.
- 7. Recipients of the Bridges to College grants must volunteer 15 hours of community service in Darke County each grant year.
- 8. Receipt of grants for any term or year does not guarantee receipt of grants in any additional year or term.
- 9. Upon further review by the Board of Trustees, students who fail to complete a term in which they received grants shall pay back such grants to Bridges to College.
- 10. The scholarship committee will give consideration to students who have participated in Bridges to College's mentoring program.
- 11. All decisions of Bridges to College with respect to the grant are final and not subject to additional review or appeal.

TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Applicant must have applied for financial aid from federal, state, and college/school sources before that institution's priority deadline or May 15, 2012, whichever comes first.
- 2. Applicant must have a 2.0 cumulative grade point average.
- 3. Applicant must mail the documents necessary to complete this application to: Bridges to College, P.O. Box 223, Greenville, OH 45331. It must be postmarked by **June 15, 2012.**
- 4. Applications that are incomplete on this date will not be considered for funding for any part of the 2012-13 school year.
