Note:

Visitors must be accompanied by the collecting/accompanying person with valid airport security identification badge at all times while in the security area.

A maximum of 3 visitors may be accompanied by each collector (holder of a regular airport security identification badge) while in the security area.

Access to the airport security area within the framework of a visitor procedure is not permitted for people whose review process (background check pursuant to Section 7 *Luftsicherheitsgesetz* [Aviation Security Act] has **not been concluded**. Requests for exceptions must be submitted in writing to the ID Service. The issue of day driving passes is subject to a charge (\in 15.00 net) which must be borne by the applicant or the visitor.

Information about data protection

The provisions of the Federal Data Protection Act, Section 28 (1), item 2 apply. The data will be saved and processed solely for recording in the computer system of the ID Service at Flughafen Berlin Brandenburg GmbH and are inaccessible to third parties.
