You are invited to submit creations designed for the human body (wearable art) to be showcased in Act Belong Commit Worn Art 2009. Creations, once entered, are judged in the category of choice of the artist and exhibited live on stage before an appreciative audience. The Worn Art show is a spectacle of music, light, creativity and theatre. Worn Art provides great opportunities for creators of all ages to experiment with familiar materials and to explore new mediums and techniques to create the weird, the wild and the wonderful.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Artwork can be entered into **any one category plus *Night Quadrille***. Please include extra entry fee if you require your costume to be judged twice in this instance. Costumes will only be accepted in the **Night time Quadrille** category if they are UV light sensitive. Please be aware that your costume may be removed from this category if it is not considered appropriate. Please consult with the director before entering a costume into this category.
- ***If an insufficient number of entries is received for a category to warrant a competition, that category will be closed and the entry will be placed in another category in consultation with the artist.***
- **All artwork/costumes must be viewed by the Artistic Director by 10 July. Please contact her on 08 91935639 or 91935658 if you have any queries regarding this. If your work is not seen by this date it will not be allowed in the show. Please deliver all artworks by mail to: Gwen Knox PO Box 2890, Broome 6726 or to the Theatre Kimberley Office at Lotteries House Cable Beach Road, Broome 6726.**
- Artists may submit any number of entries into the event. Please use one entry form per entry and ensure that all details are completed and correct.
- Entry fee per costume entry is \$15, or \$10 (Student or Concession Card Holder) or \$5 (child entry made by the child). If you want to have your entry considered for judging in Night Quadrille as well as another category please include an extra \$10. Please attach the entry fee to the entry form before submitting it.
- **All artwork must be delivered to BRAC on Tuesday 17th August between 8am and 5pm unless otherwise arranged with the production manager or artistic director**
- Cheques or money orders are welcome, please make payable to: ***Theatre Kimberley- Worn Art.***
- All monies paid will be receipted appropriately. No EFTPOS or credit facilities are available.
- Entry forms not accompanied by the entry fee will **NOT** be accepted.
- Closing date for entry forms (returned by mail) is **2nd July 5.00pm.**
- Entries will NOT be accepted past the closing deadline.
- Each artwork entry is entitled to one free ticket on a night of the Artist's choice.
- **Models must be prepared to attend ALL rehearsals.**
- All artwork will be automatically eligible for judging in the nominated category, the Overall Winner category and People's Choice Category.
- Committee members who are paid for their work on Worn Art are not eligible to win prizes.
- Organisers reserve the right to use photos of all artworks and performers submitted for promotional and marketing purposes.
- The Judges' decisions are final.
- Prizes are not redeemable for cash.
- Any costumes entered containing staples or tape that are needed to hold it together will be rejected.
- Costumes will not be performed if they are considered not fit for performance.



- Reasonable care will be taken with entries but the Worn Art committee will accept no responsibility for damage or loss and insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
