4 - Official performed this task within expectations for the entire game. A few small mistakes occurred, but these errors did not affect the flow of the game, nor change the outcome (e.g. the referee was out of position, whistles were soft, score took a long time to show up on the scoreboard).

3 - Official performed this task below expectations for a portion of the game. Errors made did not significantly impact scoring, gameplay, or the flow of the game (e.g. was out of position, did not use hand signals consistently, did not consistently perform duties between jams, scoreboard clock consistently had to be adjusted during time-outs, penalty calls were consistently missed and notations had to be corrected).

2 - Official performed this task below expectations for the entire game. Multiple errors occurred, at least one of which had a significant impact on scoring, gameplay, or the flow of the game (e.g. incorrect calls, inaccurate scoring, fair to poor assessment of impact, inaccurate timing, inaccurate penalty notation).
