Raising money

Sponsovship

We have included a sponsorship form in this pack to you to get started with your fundraising! If you would prefer to raise your sponsorship online please go to www.everydayhero.co.uk/event/manchestermidnightwalk Remember to bring your sponsorship form or print out of your online page with you on the night so we can stamp it to say you have completed the walk. That way all your sponsors will know it is time for them to give you their money!

We know that some people can find raising sponsorship tricky, so here are a few tips to set you on your way.



Set a target - tell everyone how much you are hoping to raise. Remember to break down your target into smaller chunks to make it easier.



Time - give yourself plenty of time to start your fundraising. The sooner you pass your form around the more chance you have of hitting your target.

Spread the word - Tell everyone and anyone about your fundraising. If you have an online fundraising page, email the link to everyone you know – including your friends on Facebook and Twitter.



Spice things up - Try different ways to raise your sponsorship such as a cake sale at work, carboot sale, or a raffle!



Gift Aid - Ask all your sponsors to tick Gift Aid if they are UK taxpayers. It adds an extra 25% to the amount they give you!

On the night!

Timings

9pm - Registration opens at Manchester Central. Everyone must sign in before going on the walk. You will also collect your walker number, tshirt and goody bag here. **Please also hand in your sponsorship form at registration.**

11.30pm - And we're off! The first walkers set off on the 10k route. For planning your journey home again, please give yourself plenty of time to walk the route - on average, the walk takes two hours to complete.

How to get there

Manchester Central is located in Manchester city centre – Manchester Central, Petersfield, Manchester, M2 3GX. There are a number of ways to get there:



By car: Follow signs for Manchester city centre and then signs for Manchester Central, Petersfield. If you have a sat nav, please use postcode M2 3GX.



By public transport: Train – the closest train stations to Manchester Central are Oxford Road and Deansgate, both are a 5 minute walk. Metrolink – St Peters Square is the closest stop to Manchester Central.

By foot: The pedestrian entrance to Manchester Central is on Windmill Street.

Carpark

The NCP are once again supporting St Ann's Hospice by offering our walkers a discounted parking rate for specific car parks on the night of the walk. The closest car park is Central Lower, which is directly under Manchester Central, but the offer is extended to the Oxford Rd and Great Northern NCP. To benefit from this offer, please bring your car parking ticket to the registration desk on the night where it will be validated. Once you have finished the walk you will pay the reduced rate at the car park pay machine before you exit. If you do not get your parking ticket validated you will be charged the full parking rate.

The venue

When you sign in on the night you will be allocated a walker number, tshirt (if you have not already collected it) and goodie bag. On completion of the walk, you will also be given a commemorative medal and your sponsorship form will be returned to you complete with stamp to say you have done it!



Catering facilities are available at Manchester Central on the night.



There are no cloakroom facilities available at the venue so please remember that any bags or belongings you bring along will need to be carried on the walk.



There are no cash machines in the venue, although there are a number of cash machines within walking distance.



On no account is alcohol to be brought into the venue or consumed during the walk.


