



Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program Award

Description of Award

One annual award of \$700 is provided to recognize an outstanding Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) student by the Ottawa Catholic School Board.

Candidates

Graduating students who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their OYAP.

Applicants *must* have completed all of the requirements for obtaining an OSS Diploma, including the community service component.

Selection Criteria

Particular focus, but without limiting such focus, will be given to students who:

- ♦ have demonstrated special dedication to pursuing a career in the skilled trades;
- ♦ have attained outstanding achievement in the view of their employers and cooperative education teachers;
- ♦ have demonstrated a well-rounded achievement in their education and community involvement;
- ♦ have attained outstanding achievement in the context of economic, cultural or social barriers.

The school-based Honours and Awards Selection Committee is to submit one application per school to Brenda Wilson, Superintendent, by internal courier, no later than May 10, 2013. The recipient will be determined by the Board Selection Committee.

Distribution of Information

Students will be informed of the availability of this award through mailings to the schools and through the course calendar.

Presentation of Award

The Board's OYAP Coordinator will present the award to the recipient during the graduation ceremonies.
