German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. is accepting online entries through the AKC Online System. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries: 20% (66), paper entries 80% (264), 330 runs per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered.

No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. Inquiries may be directed to Suzanne J Belger at desertmtnmalinois@gmail.com. Entries will be accepted by email with PayPal payment. All entries received with credit/debit card for payment will have a service charge added (10%). Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. GSPCA and the Trial Secretary assume(s) no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.

Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Move-up must be made on or before Monday, April 23, 2018, 6:00 PM MT.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a returned check, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their future entries being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Owners are responsible for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed.

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing April 13, 2018, 9:00 pm MT. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing April 13, 2018, 9:00 pm MT. Any entries withdrawn that are received by April 13, 2018, 9:00 pm MT will be replaced by a first received wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by April 13, 2018, 9:00 pm MT will receive a full refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against GSPCA or officials thereof.

FAST Courses will be nested with one walk-thru for all levels.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

JUDGING INFORMATION

Check-In will begin at **8:00 AM MT** on all days.

Judging will start at 9:00 AM MT on all days.

Check-in for all dogs, judge's briefing, and walk through will take place prior to start time. Electronic timers will be used. Excellent/Master level classes and Time to Beat may have split walk through depending on entry size.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Dogs that need to be measured must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service, through a public-address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple ring may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 110'x110'.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by

the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

After the close of entries, a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 21)

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

- First Place.....Blue
- Second Place..... Red
- Third Place.....Yellow
- Fourth PlaceWhite
- Qualifying Score.....Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. Ribbons and awards will not be mailed. All ribbons and prizes offered by GSPCA.

All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial. None will be mailed.

Some New Title Ribbons are for specific classes such as Time 2 Beat or the Master Classes – these will be awarded in lieu of the generic new title ribbon.

For the Sunday all-breed trial and the GSP-Only Monday trial, a High in Trial ribbon will be awarded to the highest scoring GSP according to the Risky Trophy scoring rules. The Monday GSP-only trial is considered the NSS Official Trial.

RISKY MEMORIAL CHALLENGE TROPHY and HIT RIBBON

This trophy is awarded annually at the German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America national agility trial. It is awarded to the German Shorthaired Pointer that earns a QQ with perfect scores (100s) from the Regular Excellent or Master Standard and JWW classes and has the highest average yards per second determined by averaging the YPS of the two runs across the Standard and Jumpers classes. If no QQs are earned from the regular classes, then any QQ earned from the Preferred Excellent or Master classes (ties broken similarly by YPS) will be considered. If no QQs are earned in either Regular or Preferred, then if a GSP in regular qualifies in Excellent/Master in Regular Standard, it will win. If more than one GSP were to qualify in Standard, the GSP the highest YPS will be used. If none qualify in Regular Standard, then Excellent/Master Preferred Standard will be used. If none in qualify, then Excellent/Master Regular JWW will be used, followed by Excellent/Master Preferred JWW. Similarly, if no Qualifying runs out of Excellent/Master regular or Preferred to occur in this progression, then the same progression will be used in Open, and then in Novice. NOTE: ONLY Monday's GSP-Only Trial will determine the NSS HIT/Challenge Trophy winner. A HIT for Trial GSP will also be awarded Sunday with a HIT Ribbon only.

Notice to Exhibitors

This trial will be conducted under American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc., Trial Secretary, or any official thereof.

German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc., Club officers, board members, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

All dogs must be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on trial/show grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. (AKC leash restrictions March 2009). Trial Grounds are defined as the entire rented area of Eagle Island State Park. Dogs must be on-leash in the park according to park rules whether on trial grounds or in the park.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Crating space will be available the afternoon of April 28, 2018. Crates may be left overnight. Overnight Security is not provided by the State Park at the site and all valuables and items of value should be secured overnight. GSPCA plans to have an individual camp overnight in the vicinity of the trial site area but cannot guarantee the safety of valuables left overnight at the site location. The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc. and Eagle Island State Park will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

These trials are held in outdoors on grass. The temperature can fluctuate so please be prepared for shade and shelter for a variety of temperatures.

Lunch: There are restaurants and fast food within 15 miles of the site. The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America will announce in the Judging Program what food arrangements will be available. Water in plastic bottles will be available for free to all exhibitors throughout both days.
