Thank you for your interest in the MSW program at California State University, Bakersfield!

The CSUB MSW program is fully accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE). The CSUB Social Work program offers enrollment to qualified students during the fall term only. In the fall of 2016, CSUB will convert from the quarter system to the semester system. This change will affect all MSW students who are admitted in 2015. Please see the programs of study at http://www.csub.edu/socialwork/Curriculum%20Guides/index.html for the sequence of courses.

The application deadline for admission in the fall of 2015 is February 2, 2015. It is critically important that you submit materials by that deadline. We hope the information provided will support you during the application process, and we look forward to working with you.

- Please complete an application for both the university and the Department of Social Work as described below.
- Please submit the application materials by February 2, 2015.

THE UNIVERSITY AND MSW APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Access the university application by visiting www.csumentor.edu (\$55.00 fee payable online).
- 2. Access the MSW application by visiting www.csub.edu/socialwork and clicking Social Work Admissions. Please note that computer literacy is expected. At a minimum, students should be able to retrieve electronic documents on line according to prescribed procedures. Applicants who complete and return the application will be considered to have met the computer literacy requirement.
- 3. Request that a set of original transcripts (electronic preferred) from ALL colleges and universities attended be sent to:

- 4. Complete the Personal Statement as described in the MSW application.
- 5. Obtain three letters of recommendation. Access the forms by visiting www.csub.edu/socialwork and clicking Social Work Admissions. Follow the instructions on the forms. (Referents may submit form by email or U.S. mail to Department of Social Work.) (See below.)
- 6. Submit a current résumé documenting dates and descriptions of work and volunteer experiences.

MSW PROGRAM PREREQUISITES

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- A cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4 point scale in the last 60 semester units or 90 quarter units attempted preferred. A GPA below 3.0 may be considered, at the department's discretion. If the GPA is below 3.0, please attach a separate page with your application explaining why you believe your application should be considered despite the low GPA.
- The Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is not required.

DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION

All application materials must be postmarked by **February 2, 2015**. **Incomplete and late applications will not be reviewed.** You must complete each item in the application packet. Write N/A (not applicable) in the spaces that do not apply to you. Applicants will be notified of acceptance by May 1, 2015.

The Department of Social Work promotes diversity among its students and faculty consistent with the values and ethics of the social work profession, the needs of the community, and the nondiscrimination policy of the University. Those from underrepresented populations are encouraged to apply.

ASSEMBLING YOUR APPLICATION MATERIALS

The following required documents must be submitted together with your application.

1. TRANSCRIPTS

One set of original transcripts is required from all colleges and universities attended. Electronic transcripts are preferred. CSUB students and graduates do not need to provide transcripts.

2. REFERENCES

Before sending forms to referents, read and fill in the top of each reference form. Email the forms to your referents, asking them to complete the attached form (additional pages may be attached). 3. PERSONAL STATEMENT

Write a <u>two-part essay according to the following outline</u>. All sections of the essay should be clearly titled as specified in the outline. The entire essay should be three to five pages, 12 point font, double spaced. The personal statement MUST be a demonstration of your writing ability. Having another person significantly involved in the writing of this statement could be considered plagiarism and could result in the rejection of your application.

 - C. Experiences related to social work
 - D. My aspirations as a social worker

Part Two:

- II. How to address a social problem
 - A. Definition of the problem

 - C. Justifications for focusing on the problem
 - D. Ways to address the problem
 - E. Potential obstacles to implementing the proposed solution

4. RESUME

Submit a current resume with dates and descriptions of all paid and volunteer work experience.

ADVANCED STANDING

To be eligible for Advanced Standing, students must have met all of the following requirements:

- 1. All of the requirements for a Master's degree must be completed within seven years. Therefore all BSW courses that will count toward the MSW degree must have been taken within seven years of completion of the MSW program.
- 2. The BSW must be earned from a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.
- 2. Overall GPA of 3.0 or better
- 3. Grade of B or better in all social work courses

Advanced Standing students waive foundation year requirements of the MSW program.

FINANCIAL AID for students in the Master of Social Work Program

CalSWEC (Title IV-E) Stipends

A limited number of CalSWEC (California Social Work Education Center) stipends are available to students in the Master of Social Work program. Stipends of \$18,500 per year are available for full-time students who are willing to work after graduation in a public child welfare agency in the State of California. One year of employment is required for each year of financial support received during the MSW program (normally two years). One year of field placement during the MSW program must be completed in a public child welfare agency. For more information about CalSWEC, call (661) 654-2106.

Financial assistance is also available for part-time students who are already employed at a public child welfare agency in the state of California. The financial assistance covers educational expenses associated with the MSW program up to a specified limit. Recipients are required to work for two years after graduation in a public child welfare agency in California.

CalSWEC II (Mental Health) Stipends

A limited number of CalSWEC II (Mental Health) stipends are available to students in the Master of Social Work program who are willing to work after graduation in public mental health in the State of California. Additional information will be provided to students during their first year of enrollment.

Other sources of financial aid

There may be sources of financial aid available within the MSW Department. Students will be notified when such aid is available.

Although CALSWEC assistance may replace financial aid for which a student might otherwise qualify, all students needing assistance are encouraged to apply for financial aid via the CSUB office of Financial Aid and Scholarships. The web site dedicated to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships has detailed information helpful to anyone interested in financial aid services. Please note that you must receive admission from both the university and the social work department before you can be considered for financial aid.

- 3. Advanced-standing full-time, one-year program with primarily day time classes
- 4. Advanced-standing part-time, two-year program with evening classes

Should subsequent reviews, such as a criminal record check by a placement agency, result in undisclosed criminal records, the department will have the right to respond commensurately. Students' rights to appeal are unaffected.

^{**} Your conviction of a misdemeanor or felony may not preclude your acceptance into the MSW program. However, admission into the MSW program does not guarantee acceptance by an agency for field education practicum. The law requires some agencies to conduct criminal background checks and/or drugs screens of all employees, interns, and volunteers. Thus, some agencies may not accept you for placement if you have criminal convictions or a positive drug test, and limited choices for completing the required field education practicum could impede or even block your ability to complete the MSW program. In addition, the California Board of Behavioral Sciences imposes certain restrictions on approval of professional licenses to practice clinical social work based on past criminal convictions.
