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You will need to provide your Australian Birth Certificate or Australian passport with this claim if:


- you are an Australian citizen who was born in Australia, and
- you have not travelled outside of Australia since 1 September 1994, and
- you have never claimed a Centrelink income support payment or concession card in the past.

**Confirming your identity** You may be required to confirm your identity when claiming a Health Care Card for former recipients of the Carer Allowance Health Care Card (under 16). To confirm your identity, you must provide **original** documents (not copies).

There is a complete list of acceptable documents in the *Confirming your identity* form (SS231). If you do not have this form, go to our website **humanservices.gov.au/forms**
