

How to complete the Small Estates Declaration & Indemnity form ("Small estates package")

In order that the death of the deceased shareholder in an Irish Registered Company may be noted on the Register of Members in respect of a sole shareholding it is required that you forward us the **Original Irish Grant of Probate or an official sealed copy by the Irish Probate Office**, as the shares in the Company are an Irish asset.

If it is not intended to extract an Irish Grant of Probate/Letters of Administration, you may register the shareholders death using our Small Estates Package. You may use this as long as the total value of the estate in the Republic of Ireland is not more than €20,000.

If you would like to use our Small Estates Package, please complete the Small Estates Declaration and Indemnity form and return to us completed, signed and stamped by Solicitor/Commissioner of Oaths to witness the personal representative(s) full name, address and signature(s). You are also required to enclose the following documents:

- The original death certificate or a copy stamped and certified by a Solicitor or bank
- A cheque, bankers draft or postal order made payable to 'Capita Registrars (Ireland) Limited' for €175.00 (including VAT of 23%), or the sterling equivalent. You will need to check the conversation rate on-line or with your local bank. This administration fee is to cover the administration and guarantee fees needed to protect against any possible future claims that may result from recording the death without an Irish Grant of Probate/Letters of Administration.

If you would like to transfer the shares after the death of the shareholder has been registered, please complete a Stock Transfer Form. Our Stock Transfer Form and guidance notes can be found on our website www.capitaassetservices.com and should be completed and returned back to us along with the relevant share certificate(s).

We wish to advise that only when the death of the deceased has been noted on the Register can any documents be amended to note the capacity of the personal representative(s) or the shares be transferred/sold.

Please note you are under no obligation to use our Small Estates package. If you do not want to use Small Estates package, please send us an original or office sealed copy of an Irish Grant of Probate/ Letter of Administration and we will register the shareholder's death free of charge.

When returning the legal documents required to register the death you may also enclose the original share certificate(s) for replacement. However, existing valid share certificates remain valid. If you do not have the original share certificate(s) for the total holding and wish to obtain duplicate share certificate(s) please send us a signed request for a letter of Indemnity for duplicate share certificate.
