Early Field Experience (For <u>all</u> Education Specialist Credential applicants)

Title 5 Regulations from the *California State University Chancellor's Office* requires each Education credential candidate to have participated in a supervised Early Field Experience in a *school setting* prior to admission to a credential program. Applicants for an Education Specialist Credential should fulfill a minimum requirement of 45 hours of field experience *prior* to entrance into an Education Specialist Credential Program.

Note: The classroom experience should match the credential program for which you are applying (Mild/Moderate, Deaf/Hard of Hearing, Visual Impairment, etc.)

The classroom teacher who has observed you in his/her classroom as a volunteer or as a paid aide is in the best position to give us this information. Others who might be in position to assess your potential based on your classroom experience could be the principal of the school or another district administrator.

- 1. Completion of 45 hours paid experience as a teacher aide or teacher assistant the majority of which time has been direct or indirect contact with students. This may be verified by the teacher to whom the aide or assistant is assigned or by a site administrator or a district administrator.
- 2. Completion of 45 clock hours as a classroom teacher either in a public school with an emergency credential, as a substitute teacher, or in a private school as verified by administrator.
- ______ 3. Completion of 45 clock hours working with students as a volunteer in a special education classroom with a credentialed teacher.
- 4. Successful completion of any course or courses which have a field experience in which you worked with children or young adults. Please note course(s) and include a copy of transcript and/or course description for verification.
- 5. I have completed the following activity that is equivalent to above activities. Attach a description of this activity and verification of completion.

REMEMBER: A letter of reference for early field experience is required in addition to this form.

The Early Field Experience is an important part of your application because it verifies that you have first hand experience in a special education classroom setting. All of our credential courses are based on your first hand experience and preliminary understandings of, or exposure to, the teaching/learning process in a special education classroom.
