Acceptable student scholarly work includes thesis research (e.g. for a graduate degree, for the honor's program), research conducted as part of the Faculty/Student Research Program (FSRP) or resulting from a President's Fellowship for Summer Research, and undergraduate or graduate research *or other scholarly projects* carried out as independent study. If students have engaged in extramural research, we would be glad to include that as well.

Recognizing that poster format can be too restrictive for non-science disciplines, we are including oral and creative presentations as well. This format has become popular over the past four years, and we would like to encourage more students to take advantage of this opportunity. Please ask your students to be specific about their format needs when completing the attached form. Scholarly work that has been previously presented or published elsewhere is welcome. We are excited about this opportunity to recognize the scholarly and creative work of students and their faculty mentors. Students who participate in the event will receive a commemorative gift from the University and be invited, with their mentors, to attend a celebratory dinner the evening of the program.
