JUVENILE & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Each sex will be judged separately (each class divided by sex). The Saskatoon Area Shetland Sheepdog Association will retain 20% of each entry fee for expenses. Juvenile Sweepstakes classes offered: Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12-18 months.

Veteran Sweepstakes classes offered: 7-9 years, 9+ years.

The remaining 80% shall be awarded as follows:

First in each class	25% of entry fee & rosette
Second in each class	20% of entry fee & rosette
Third in each class	15% of entry fee & rosette
Fourth in each class	10% of entry fee & rosette

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES will receive 10% of total entry fee & rosette.

RUNNER-UP TO BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES will receive a rosette.

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All of these classes must be divided by sex. Note: no dogs under the age of six months on the first day of the show shall be allowed within the Show precincts as defined in the Premium List. Every dog within these must be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes or in Exhibition Only.

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs nine months of age and under twelve months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH: for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any other country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder /co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: for all dogs.

VETERANS: for dogs 7 years of age and over. Can be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

ALTERED CLASS: Entrants must be over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. All classes as above apply. All disqualifications shall apply except for those which disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conf competition.

NON REGULAR CLASSES:

**Dogs entered in Non Regular Classes must be entered in an Official Class or Exhibition Only.

Stud & Get - Any sire and 2 or more of his offspring.

Brood Bitch & Progeny - Any dam and 2 or more of her offspring. *Please indicate the Get OR Progeny on the Get or Progeny Entry Form.*

Brace (Conformation) - Any 2 dogs of either sex. Please attach the info for the second dog to the first dog's entry form.

Baby Puppy: 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. The class is to be judged after breed judging, after Group judging and Prior to Judging of Best in Show. **Baby Puppies are exempt from paying the Exhibition Only fee.**

Parade of Title Holders: For Shelties that have achieved any CKC recognized Title. Please supply a brief write up, about 100 words including the dogs Registered & Call names, along with your entry or send to ShowSec separately. Will be held after Best In Specialty.

Exhibition Only: (3 – 6 months) For dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.
