COURSE PROCEDURE

Homework will be assigned every day, due the next school day. Students will do homework in spiral binders, provided by the teacher.

HOMEWORK/TEST POLICY

Homework must be all completed prior to unit exam. In this class, even if the homework is not done, the student will take the test, but the score will be held until the work is turned in.

If a unit exam is missed, the student must set up an appointment with instructor upon returning to school, to be taken outside of regular school hours at a scheduled study time. An appointment calendar will be provided for this. No make-up exams or other assessments will be given during regular class time.

Grades will be posted online in the Zangle system. Class-participation points will be posted separately each day on the class web site.

GRADE COMPONENTS

Points on tests and quizzes are worth more than homework points, as described in this schedule. Extra-credit will be assigned occasionally but will be available only to students who are current with their assigned work.

MEDIA

Students will be offered multiple opportunities during the year to develop digital content, such as podcasts, Powerpoint presentations and digital movies (to be shown in class only). CLASSROOM RULES

CONSEQUENCES

In order to do this, I will use the following incremental steps to address behavior issues in my classroom:

- •Warn the student about the specific behavior issue.
- •Invite the student to sit in the pod for 5 minutes, written apology required for re-admission.
- •Assign home/parental behavior description form, due the following school day.
- •Assign 5-minute lunch detention on the day following the incident. *
- •Assign 30-minute lunch detention on the day following the incident. *
- •Referral to student discipline.
 - * Refusal to show for detention is equivalent to defiance to the teacher (Cal. Education Code) and will automatically result in a one-day ISS (In-School Suspension).

TARDIES

According to Palm Springs High School attendance policy, a student is tardy if he/she is not inside the classroom when the tardy bell stops ringing. I will secure my classroom door at that time and only admit students with valid excused passes. All other tardy students will be assigned by Security to ISS (In-School Suspension) where they will remain until the end of the period.

ACADEMIC DISHONESTY

No tolerance whatsoever! Both the receiver and the giver are equally dishonest and violate school policy. Punishment will follow the **discipline code** and will include immediate **loss of all points** for the assignment/test with no possibility for make-up, parent contact, and possible community service.
