Position Overview:

The Active Start Learning Facilitator will be responsible for overseeing and managing weekly soccer sessions for players ages U4-U6. With the assistance and support of the team's volunteer coach and parents, Learning Facilitators will run 15 – 20 minute informal play activity sessions with each team to help players develop their physical literacy skills (running, kicking, shooting, changing direction, etc.). These fun, interactive sessions encourage children to have fun while becoming comfortable with the game of soccer.

If you are a high energy individual who loves working with young children and are passionate about soccer, this is the ideal position for you.
