Directions to Bethel

From the North:

Take I-35W south to the County Road E2 exit. Go east to Old S.T.H. 10 (Snelling Ave.), turn right, and take the first left into campus. Or take I-694 east to the Snelling Ave. (Highway 51) turnoff and proceed to campus entrance on the right, one-quarter mile south.

From the West:

Take I-694 east to the Snelling Ave. (Highway 51) turnoff and proceed to campus entrance on the right, one-quarter mile south.

From the East:

Take I-694 to I-35W south to the County Road E2 exit. Go east to Old S.T.H. 10 (Snelling Ave.), turn right, and take the first left into campus.

From Downtown Minneapolis:


