Requirements

The Anatomy & Physiology program is offers one \$750.00 scholarship to a student that has completed either Anatomy or Physiology and is planning on taking the remaining course within the next year. To be eligible applicants must meet the following criteria: 1) Student has completed at least 12 units at Contra Costa College including 4 units of either Anatomy or Physiology with an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher and a minimum grade of B in the specific Anatomy or Physiology course; 2) Student is enrolled in a minimum of 9 units for the Spring 2015 semester; 3) Student will continue at Contra Costa College as a full-time student in the Fall 2015 semester, completing the Anatomy and Physiology sequence within a year of the award. In addition to meeting the criteria above, the applicant also needs to write a short essay stating why they deserve the scholarship.

Award Redemption Policy
