First preference given to residents of Beaufort, Colleton, Hampton, and Jasper Counties. Second preference given to residents of other South Carolina counties, and finally to applicants from other states.</li> <li>c. Preference is given to those students who have not previously been admitted to the Medical Assisting Program.</li> </ol>				
<b>II. TEAS test score:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Good for 3 years</li> <li>b. May be taken twice within a 12 month period prior to application deadline</li> <li>c. If taken twice within 12 months only the highest score will be considered</li> <li>d. <i>All TEAS test Results must be included (not just those taken within the past 12 months)</i></li> </ol>
