## 2014 FEDERAL INCOME TAX FILING REQUIREMENTS

This information is from the 2014 IRS 1040 and 1040A Instruction Booklets (see www.irs.gov).

Amounts listed are for people under the age of 65; if you are over 65, please refer to the IRS instruction booklets.

For most people, a tax return must be filed with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) if their 2014 income was at least:

Single dependent student (your parents or someone else can claim you as a dependent)	\$6,200 (earned income) (\$1,000 un- earned income)	Married, filing separately	\$3,950 (gross income)
Single, if claiming self	\$10,150 (gross income)	Head of household	\$13,050 (gross income)
Married, filing joint return	\$20,300 (gross income)	Qualifying widow(er) with dependent child	\$16,350 (gross income)

Earned income includes salaries, wages, tips, professional fees, and taxable scholarship and fellowship grants.

**Unearned income** includes taxable interest, ordinary dividends, and capital gain distributions. It also includes unemployment compensation, taxable social security benefits, pensions, annuities, and distributions of unearned income from a trust.

**Self-employment:** You have to file an income tax return if your net earnings from self-employment were \$400 or more.

## Who is self-employed?

- You carry on a trade or business as a sole proprietor or an independent contractor.
- You are a member of a partnership that carries on a trade or business.
- You are otherwise in business for yourself (including a part-time business). A trade or business is generally an activity carried on for a livelihood or in good faith to make a profit (i.e. babysitting, lawn care, repairs, etc.)
