2015 GEAR UP Virginia Poster Contest Entry Rules

In recognition of National GEAR UP Week, GEAR UP Virginia (GUV) is holding its first poster contest. Participants must be members of the 2014-21 GUV cohort with a signed release form on file at the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia.

Design Requirements

- Create a poster using the theme "GEARing Up for College."
- The design must not contain any wording, including the theme, "GEARing Up for College."
- Acrylic, chalk, colored pencils, crayon, ink, oil pastel, pastel, tempera paint, watercolor, and all other drawing and painting mediums will be accepted.
 Sculptures and similar multi-dimensional designs will not be accepted.
- The design may be produced electronically using computer graphic software such as programs from Adobe Creative Suite 6 or older. Please enclose a CD or flash drive as well as a color hard copy of the design.
- Do not submit folded artwork. Folded entries will not be accepted.
- Entries should be 11" x 17" or less. Entries over maximum size of 11" x 17" will not be accepted.
- Selection criteria include the following: design (cohesiveness of composition), expression (communicative quality), connection to the theme, and originality (novel or unique solution).

Additional Information

- All submissions must be accompanied by a **completed** student entry form with required signatures that **must be affixed to the back of the artwork**.
- The winning design will be reproduced into a new GUV poster to be distributed with all GUV schools.
- GUV reserves the right to enhance and/or alter original artwork if selected for reproduction.
- The winner will be announced in January 2016, and the poster will be unveiled at the January Virginia Board of Education meeting. The winner will receive a certificate of recognition, a professional print of their poster design, and a Virginia529 College Savings Account in the amount of \$100.00. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
