
ELA/ELD Framework

Revisions to the Second Draft:

- All chapters revised for clarity
- Chapter 7 split into two grade span chapters Grades 6–8 and Grades 9–12
- New section in grade-level chapters, "Supporting Students Strategically"
- Repetition reduced with increased references to other chapters/sections
- UDL and MTSS included in general education, in addition to the Access and Equity chapter
- More information on EL newcomers
- Referenced content-area information/standards more closely aligned and vetted

Knowledge of Language:


- Structuring cohesive texts

2015 ELA/ELD Instructional Materials Review

- Recruiting reviewers until August 1, 2014
- Two types of reviewers:
- 1) Instructional Materials Reviewer (IMR)
- Content Review Expert (CRE): Master's degree or higher + 5 or more years of experience or doctoral degree in research on how reading skills are acquired



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2015 ELA/ELD Instructional Materials Review (cont.)

- Assigned to one of two sessions based on expertise and number and types of programs submitted
- Both training & deliberations held at Sheraton Hotel LAX in LA
- Training: Session I April 13–15 and Session II April 27–May 1
- Deliberations: Session I July 13–17 and Session II July 27–31
