
Educational Travel Credit Proposal Form

Educational Travel is defined as a planned learning experience gained through participation in a travel/study tour. Students whose travel is extended for a semester or more should enroll in the district's Correspondence School for courses that will meet District graduation requirements. Contingent on this prior approval, a student will receive a .5 credit for a three-week study/tour program or 1 credit for a six-week program which will be recorded with a P (Pass) grade, which is not included in calculating GPA. Educational Travel study for credit must be initiated by the student and it is the student's responsibility to meet all of the requirements and complete all associated paperwork.
