- For other dates of second chance try-outs, please contact the OSU Extension Office at 576-9008. You must have a letter of permission from the Ashtabula Co. 4-H Educator to take to the other county's 4-H PAS Show in order to participate.

Anyone may enter the tryouts with the following exceptions: Any member who has not complied with rules set forth by Uniform Rules and/or Ashtabula County Saddle Horse Committee rules.

Selection will be made based on the judging score from tryouts on the above dates. Members will compete in at least 2 and not more than 4 classes. If member receives the required score/time (see attached sheet) in the class they will be allowed to go to State Fair. Participants in classes requiring equipment are expected to assist in setting up and clearing the ring.

I would like to compete in State Fair tryout competition in the following four (4) classes and if I receive the minimum score or maximum times to qualify for these classes I can choose which two (2) I will enter at the State Fair. (You must qualify in at least two (2) classes in order to go to the State Fair. If you only want to try out in 2 or 3 classes, you may.) I understand that I must use my 2013 project animal.
