### Sophomore Registration Procedure:

- 1. Pre-registration will occur on-line through the ABI Gradebook:
  - Go to district website (<u>www.bonita.k12.ca.us</u>)
  - Move down the page to the "Parents and Students" section
  - Click Parent ABI Gradebook
  - Enter e-mail address and password (student or parent) to log into ABI Gradebook
  - Click Student Info tab; click Course Requests
  - Enter the course number for each course desired maximum 6 courses.
- The ABI pre-registration window will be open <u>until 11:59 PM, Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup></u>. The school library will be available to pre-register and will be open each school day until 3:30 PM, or you may access ABI at home.
- 3. Complete the **attached pre-registration form** with the **exact titles** and **course numbers** of the courses you have selected as part of your pre-registration for next year. 10<sup>th</sup> Graders must enroll in **English, Math, Science, World History and PE** (Biology, WH or PE may be taken in summer school subject to availability Summer Biology students must enroll in a science class during the year)
- 4. See reverse side for graduation and UC/CSU a-g requirements.
- 5. Students will be meeting with their counselors during an English class in late February to review their selections.
- 6. Please remember that if you don't pre-register for a course, you will likely <u>NOT</u> be able to register for the course during fall registration.
- 7. Also remember that you will be expected to remain enrolled in the course that you choose.
- 8. Over-subscribed courses will be assigned based on GPA, pre-requisites and/or grade level.
- 9. If you are registering for any AP classes, you must submit a completed <u>AP application</u>.
- 10. ROP students must be 16 years old by October 31<sup>st</sup> to enroll in an ROP course.
- 11. Remember to get all proper permit signatures or completed applications see below.
- 12. If you plan to register for summer school, indicate the course you would like to take, e.g. Biology, World History, Art, etc. (You must still complete a separate summer application in order to be registered for summer school – this document is for information purposes.)
