Order, etc. and made payable to University College Cork. All students are liable for course fees. Fees are charged per credit weighting on the basis of the full tuition fee. Late Application: For applications made after the specified closing date, a late application fee

of €50 applies. Please note: If you are successful in your late flexi-options application, it is your responsibility to bring yourself up to date with course work. In no case can acceptance of a late application be cited by students as grounds for poor performance at examinations late in the academic year. In addition, as a consequence of making a late application, your registration for flexi-options will be delayed, your student ID card will take longer to issue, and you will not have immediate access to the Library, Blackboard and other

student services.
